INFANTRY 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ to close with the enemy by fire or maneuver, to destroy or capture him or repels his attack
ARTILLERY 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ to destroy, neutralize or suppress the enemy by cannon, rocket and missile fire
ARMOR 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ to combine tanks and armored cavalry
Corps of Engineers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ to facilitate the movement of friendly forces (to construct bridges, demolish obstacles, demine fields)
Signal Corps 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ to transmit, use and maintain information
