Positive		Negative		Question		Short answer
I	was	I	wasn't	Was	I	Yes, I was/No, I wasn't.
you	were	you	weren't	Were	you	
he	was	he	wasn't	Was	he	Yes, you/we/they were. No, you/we/they weren't.
she	was invited	she	wasn't invited	Was	she invited	
it	was built	it	wasn't built	Was	it built	Yes, he/she/it was. No, he/she/it wasn't.
we	were	we	weren't	Were	we	
you	were	you	weren't	Were	you	
they	were	they	weren't	Were	they
