The world's smallest gun

According to Guinness World Records, the title of the smallest working _____ (1) in the world goes to the **Miniature Revolver C1ST**, manufactured by **SwissMiniGun**. The tiny _____ (2) measures just more than 5.5cm and weighs less than 28.35 gm.
